Link Construction Group would like to remember the prominent businessman, philanthropist, and heralded figure in the sports world, John Brunetti Sr.



As a student of University of Miami, in the 1950s, Brunetti had a passion for horse-racing in South Florida and he fell in love with the beautiful Hialeah Race Track. He went on to create a successful real estate and construction business in New Jersey and Florida and purchased his beloved race track in 1977.

As his love for horse racing continued through breeding and competing, he fought to return his race track to its

historic glory days. Through his tireless vision, Mr. Brunetti

restored Hialeah Park and Casino, bringing back racing

and gaming, which has renewed the beauty and the popularity of the park.

As a philanthropist, he gave generously to his alma mater, University of Miami, for medical research, athletics, and education. He was also a great proponent for human rights, veteran's services, public broadcasting, and for the humane retirement of thoroughbred race horses.

John Brunetti Sr. was 87 years old. He is survived by his wife, Tracee; his sons, John Jr. and Steven; and his sister, JoAnn Brunetti.

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## Featured Completed PROJECTS

#### JOE DIMAGGIO **CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL ER EXPANSION**

HOLLYWOOD, FL

This project consisted of a 5,430 SF renovation and 3,407 SF expansion to the existing Pediatric Emergency Room Department, located at the hospital's main campus. This project addresses the facility's high demand through the expansion of fast track services within the existing pediatric ED department. Treatment and Support spaces included in this project are seven holding bays, nine exam rooms (five of which have isolation capabilities), triage, nurses' station, administrative and operational offices, staff lounge, reception and waiting areas. storage facilities. environmental services, laboratory room, voluntary work area, clean supply room, and a soil workroom. New roof top air handler unit and new electrical distribution panel-boards are some building system improvements also associated with this project.

All work was performed within a fully functional campus in consideration to the health and safety of all patients and staff.

## ... BUILDING ACTION FOR SOUTH FLORIDA



Link has recently completed the construction for this new Florida City Fronton & Poker Room. The site sits on 8 of the 38 acres, that will eventually be developed by Kings Court Key, an affiliate of Hialeah Park. The project, which was designed by Ewing Cole in collaboration with Beame Architects, includes site improvements, a Sprung Tent Structure to house the Jai Alai Court, and a separate, modular building, which serves as its Poker Room.

This project has become another destination to attract visitors to South Miami-Dade County.

Florida City Mayor Otis Wallace sees this as "a catalyst for further development of other businesses and just one more destination to draw visitors."



#### TD BANK ON WEST FLAGLER STREET

This branch is a one story, 2,550 SF bank, with a business occupancy classification. and class IIB construction type. It includes a 3-lane, remote drive-through canopy, consisting of steel structure and photovoltaic panels for the roof covering. Life safety systems include smoke detectors in the mechanical return air ducts, with individual monitoring stations. Energy systems include photovoltaic panels on both the drive through canopy roof and main roof, lighting controls, occupancy sensors, low flow plumbing fixtures, tight thermal envelope, and solar sunshades on the windows. Pending LEED Gold Certification.



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#### TRUJILLO BROTHERS DISTRIBUTION HEADQUARTERS

MIAMI, FL

A new 151,380 SF, dock height, tilt-wall warehouse and office building on an approximately 5.7 acres site. Structure consists of tilt up with twin tee roof structure. Incorporated in the design is the office portion - two stories with complete quality finishes. The warehouse portion will be conditioned with +/- 18,000 SF of freezer and cooler. The dock equipment selected consists of levelers, restraints, speed doors, rail leveler and dock shelters.

THE AUTO FIRM

This project's execution entailed the demolition and remodeling of the interior office, the conversion of a portion of the warehouse space into office space, installation of four new AC split systems, installation of a compressed air system for the mechanic shop, a new fire alarm system, new lighting inside offices and warehouse, new ACT, placement of new tile throughout, resealing and restriping of parking lot, and demolition and install of handicap ramp into building.

Beacon Lakes is a premier, masterplanned, commercial development, located in the Airport West/Doral submarket, with Class-A, institutional-grade logistics and distribution space.

The park includes 478 acres ready for industrial and retail development. Beacon Lakes provides 4.6 million square feet of Class-A warehouse and 495,000 square feet of future retail development.

Our team along with MDCPS kicked-off another GOB project for a New K-8 Center in West Kendall. Zyscovich and our team have been commissioned to deliver the \$15.8 million Phase I of the new school, which will be named at a future date. Phase I consists of a new 58,765 SF, two-story facility which will house 750 student stations and includes: classrooms, labs, student and staff restrooms, media center with media production lab, digital iTV and CCTV, Administrative Area, full-production kitchen and serving areas accommodating 1,200 student stations, interior dining area, music lab/performance platform, P.E. shelter, primary and kindergarten play areas, parent and bus drop-offs and covered walkways, staff and visitor parking, service yard, landscaping, drainage and irrigation systems, perimeter fencing, and a marquee sign.





#### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS CUTLER BAY MIDDLE SCHOOL

CUTLER BAY, FL

This project is part of Miami-Dade County Public School's General Obligation Bond. Various areas of the school will be remodeled and renovated. Our team will replace Building 1, 2, 3 and 4. We will also renovate the cafeteria/kitchen.

A new 3-story, 45,000 SF building will be added. The objective of the project is to provide a total of 1,217 student stations. The new construction would provide approximately 615 new student stations and the remaining buildings 5 and 6, combined with the Music Lab in the Auditorium provide a total of 602 existing student stations.

#### DOWNTOWN DORAL CHARTER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL EXPANSION

DORAL, FL

Link has been contracted to perform the expansion at the Downtown Doral Charter Elementary School, that we recently completed for Codina Partners and MDCPS. This 2-story, 12 class room expansion, is 12,000 SF, with a new artificial turf field and an exterior dining pavilion. All work is being completed while the facility if fully occupied and active. We also remodeled an existing classroom into a computer lab, added a teacher lounge, and a counselors area.



#### DESIGN-BUILD SERVICES FOR FIRE STATION NO. 2 ADDITION/RENOVATIONS & A NEW TROLLEY MAINTENANCE BUILDING

CORAL GABLES, FL

Link Construction Group has teamed up with Silva Architects to perform Design-Build services for City of Coral Gables' Fire Station No. 2, located at 525 S. Dixie Highway. In addition to performing renovations and additions to this iconic Fire Station, the second phase of this project will feature a new Trolley Maintenance Building, to serve the City Beautiful's public transportation needs. This project will be developed to receive LEED Silver certification, and will plan for continuous operations while construction proceeds.



### LITTLE HAVANA NUTRITION & ACTIVITIES CENTER CORPORATE OFFICE

Situated in the heart of Miami's famous Little Havana District, Link Construction Group is currently constructing a 4-story building, to be used as a commercial, multi-purpose community complex, while also serving as little LHANC's corporate headquarters. The project includes a parking lot area and a playground which meet and/or exceed local code requirements. This building is built on a recently empty lot, adjacent to the existing Little Havana Nutrition & Activities Center. Once this new building has the City approval for occupancy, LHANC will move out from the old to the new building. Following the move, the project will proceed to the final phase, which is to demolish the existing building and start building the parking lot.

This new building, designed for high occupancy, will have a fully operational fire sprinkler system, elevators, child and adult daycare, health clinic, office areas, fitness center, dining area, entertainment and multi-purpose rooms. Little Havana Nutrition & Activities Center's building has 43,099 SF of gross bldg area and provides 103 parking spaces—20 on street and 83 in new parking lot.

In continuing with our successful client relationship, this will be the third project Link Construction Group will have completed for Little Havana Nutrition & Activities Center.

9 ou may have noticed that Link has been flying a drone over our jobsites. The Link drone is a DJI Mavic Pro, that is capable of flying up to 400 feet, over our projects, as long as FAA airspace, and weather, allow us to do so.

Currently, the drone is being used to showcase certain construction phases that require a lot of ground movement and that can be seen from the air. Excavations, concrete pours, flying panels, and roof installations are ideal for aerial action shots. We also fly out for a project's events such as ground breakings and grand openings.

With the drone's GPS positioning and stabilization, it records the jobsite as smooth as a helicopter would. It could also take photo stills of the entire site, as long as the size of project fits in the camera's viewer from the maximum height.

The drone footage is used to highlight the excellent work we put into our jobs, for social media, and other marketing materials. We also send the footage to the project's owners so they can get a dynamic view of how their project is coming along, and to have an interesting historic record of how their property came about.
